

FLUTE - 2023 Summer Symphony

Musicians should be skilled in all major and minor keys, be able to play with continuous vibrato, and have the ability to double and triple tongue. Please prepare and record the following for your audition:

SCALES

- C major - 3 octaves in sixteenth notes (quarter note = 60)
- C-sharp minor - 2 octaves (3 octaves optional) in sixteenth notes (quarter note = 60)
- Chromatic - 3 octaves (begin on C) in sixteenth notes (quarter note = 60)

SOLO

- your choice - 3 minutes or less
